Dogs are measured while in a standing position on a flat surface. The measurement is taken from the top of the dog's withers. All dogs, except the 26 & 22 inch divisions and the 20inch Select, must have an official measurement when at their first show. If your official dog's measurement moves you into a different height than the one entered, you must notify the show secretary and your dog will be moved.

## AWARDS

For all Classes except Nursery classes – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, & 4<sup>th</sup> Place Ribbons and Clear Round Ribbons

A qualifying Score must be gained to be awarded a Ribbon.

For all Nursery Classes, only Clear Round Ribbons will be awarded.

## Trial Site & Information

### DIRECTIONS

**From the North:** I-15 South. Exit Rancho California Road, turn left go over freeway heading East. (Approx. 8 miles) Go through wine country; turn right on Glen Oaks Road (stop sign) drive to first stop sign (Approx. 2.5 miles) turn right on De Portola Road drive (approx. 1 mile) turn left at Via De Oro (Glen Oak Hills North entrance) FIRST IMMEDIATE LEFT is Los Ranchos Circle, turn left. Home is on the left, long driveway, two large pillars, white fencing and lots of palm trees!

**From the South:** 1-15 North. Exit Rancho California Road, turn right at signal heading East. (Approx. 8 miles) Go through wine country; turn right on Glen Oaks Road (stop sign) drive to first stop sign (Approx. 2.5 miles) turn right on De Portola Road drive (approx. 1 mile) turn left at Via De Oro (Glen Oak Hills North entrance) FIRST IMMEDIATE LEFT is Los Ranchos Circle, turn left. Home is on the left, long driveway, two large pillars, white fencing and lots of palm trees!

**Freeway West:** Exit Scott Road turn left over freeway heading South. Stay on Scott Road, it will change names several times (Washington, Borrel, Rancho California) – do not turn until you come to Glen Oaks Road. (Approx. 15 miles +/-) then at the stop sign you will turn Left on to Glen Oaks Road. drive to first stop sign (Approx. 2.5 miles) turn right on DePortola Road drive (approx. 1 mile) turn left at Via De Oro (Glen Oak Hills North entrance) FIRST IMMEDIATE LEFT is Los Ranchos Circle, turn left. Home is on the left, long driveway, two large pillars, white fencing and lots of palm trees!

**Trial Site Rules:** Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. Reminder, this trial site is a residence. Please keep your dogs as quiet as possible and clean up everything that you bring. Be respectful of all the neighbors. **Drive very slowly** on property as parking area is shared with crating area. Note, arena and crating area will be fully lighted. Driveway is narrow, however please stay to your right and there is plenty of room for two people to share. Do not allow your dogs off leash or unattended unless in arena or warm up area – this is the country and other animals of the wild are not in our control.

**Food Services:** There are various restaurants and fast food vendors within a 15 minute driving distance. Lunch will be provided for workers. We will also have lunches available for a small donation for those not working.

**Crating:** The crating area is all dirt and is also shared with the parking area. Make sure that your dogs will be secure at all times.

## **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS (The boring stuff!!)**

**UK Agility International Rules and Regulations** apply to the whole event and all people and dogs must comply with these at all times. As a competitor it is your responsibility to be aware of the rules and regulations as they stand at the time of the show. This show will run under the 2010 UK Agility International rules.

**All dogs and handlers must be registered with UK Agility International in order to compete.** UK Agility International's official rules & regulations are given free on registration of Handler/Owner to UKI. If you or your dog is not already registered, fill out the UKI registration form included in this schedule and add the registration fee to your entry fee.

Competitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of **UK Agility International rules and regulations** including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete in UK Agility International Trials, with the exception of dogs over 15 calendar months of age eligible to compete in Nursery Classes & Speed Stakes.

Entries without fees paid in full will be returned. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or Guardian if the competitor is a minor. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees. If you use a recorded delivery service, you must specify No Signature Required.

**Refund Policy** Entries will not be accepted, changed or altered after the closing date or capping level has been reached except for the purpose of moving to a higher level. A full refund is available for any membership that is not older than 14 days from the creation of the account date. A full refund is available before the closing date or capping level is met for any show. There will be no cost if refund money is to be left in your UK Agility International account. If money is to be returned then the following administration costs will be incurred. If payment was received by check or money order then a \$4 administration fee will be incurred. If payment was received by credit card a 3% charge of the refund will be assessed, per transaction. If payment was received from a Pay Pal account, a 5% charge of the refund will be assessed, per transaction. Once a show has been closed and/or capped refunds of any kind for any reason will not be available.

A dog shall be withdrawn from competition without refund if it is: a bitch in season, suffering from any infectious or contagious disease, interfering with the safety of any person or other animal or if it is likely to cause itself damage or suffering if it continues competing.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn and neither in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from the competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal providing this was within accordance of UK Agility International rules and regulations.

It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Handlers working more than one dog in a class **must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn**. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

It is expressly understood that **Competitors alone are responsible** for the behavior of their dogs, children and guests. Any competitor whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the show management, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, guests from the event grounds. No refunds of fees will be made in such a case.

No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.

No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.

Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge, the show management reserves the right to appoint another judge. Should circumstances so dictate the show manager, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to UK Agility International. In the event of abandonment of the show through circumstances beyond our control, the SHOW MANAGEMENT may defray such expenses from the entry fee to cover the cost of the show preparation. These accounts will then be made public.

All dogs are entered at this show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken the show management will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show. All competitors **MUST** clean up after their dogs at all times. Failure to do so will result in competitors being asked to leave the Show.

Dogs left in hot cars, or dogs appearing to be in distress, will be dealt with as seen fit by the Show Management.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. **There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks.** Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made before a competitor may compete. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls to a UK Agility International account must be paid prior to the start of the event. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice shall be reported to UK Agility International. UK Agility International will suspend a dog's/handlers registration until fees are paid in full. If your UK Agility International account owes money when we process the entries for this show your running orders may be withheld to encourage you to visit the secretaries tent at the show so that the account balance can be resolved.

Due to UKI trial availability of more than 4 months and within 150 miles, this Trial is eligible for move up using the transfer table (see page 2) even if the dog is already competing in UKI at a lower level. Online entries must first email [laura@ukagility.com](mailto:laura@ukagility.com) to arrange for level moveup.

Please remember that it's to your benefit to sign up for a UKI trial online. Online entry fees are \$12.00 for each handler/dog as opposed to paying \$15.00 for each handler/dog if you sign up on the day of trial.

**DAY-OF-SHOW ENTRIES:** Just to be clear, if you do wish to do a day-of-show entry, you will pay for your runs on the day of the show, you will just not be paying for your handler and dog registration fees. You will, however, fill out the Handler Entry Form and circle “TBYB” on the application and submit that with the Dog Entry Form. If you wish to keep any points you might accumulate for your runs, you will have **7 (seven)** days to turn in your online registration and pay for your handler and dog registration. Otherwise, any points you have accumulated will be discarded. Day-of-show entrants will complete their own scribe sheet(s) for any classes that you enter (or add), and it is your responsibility to let the gate steward know that you are a day-of-show entry. You will then be added onto the gate sheet under the appropriate jump height. There will be tables set up for day-of-show entries, and we will be happy to answer any questions you might have.

**Try Before You Buy! Registration Details** TBYB will allow you to enter your first UKI trial and pay for that Entry either online or by sending a check, and if after your first UKI trial, you would like to keep your membership with UKI, payment for registration will be due 7 working days after that trial. You will then be sent your registration documents, including your rule and record books. The competitor must first create an account, through our web page (or by paper registration) and must notify us by emailing [info@ukagilityinternational.com](mailto:info@ukagilityinternational.com) of their wish to do a TBYB. This means they will not have to pay immediately for their membership with UKI, or at all should they decide not to enter any other shows and do not want to keep any points they earned towards their titles. If the TBYB is submitted using paper registration, the UKI office will create an account for you. When registration is due, the amount will be charged at the higher paper registration fee (\$15 handler membership and \$15 dog membership). An online account cannot then be created later by the competitor for the discounted online fee. Therefore, it is in the competitor’s best interest to create an ONLINE account in the first place so when the competitor decides to keep their membership, they will have received the (\$12 handler membership fee and the \$12 dog membership fee).
